RIVER ANGEL broke sharply setting all the pace, raced in the two path around the bend, began to tire a sixteenth out, was kept to task holding safe to the wire. INDIAN CARLIE broke well stalking the winner from the start, hard ridden from upper stretch, did narrow the gap late while proving to be easily second best. LADY FLICKER was outrun to top of the stretch, found belated stride and surged along the rail late to just get the show position on the wire. PREEMINENT raced up close traveling three wide to mid turn, began to drop off top of the lane, gave way inside the eighth pole and was nipped on the wire losing the show position. SWEETHEART SORDITA was quickly outrun, lagged throughout in a dull effort.
