FITZ N GIGGLES duled briefly then was taken back and angled off the rail, bid mid turn to engage REBELLION DOG for the lead, quickly drove by entering the stretch and widened being kept to task. KYLE'S PAL settled in mid pack, bid four wide at the quarter pole, chased the winner throughout the stretch run never threatening and just held on to second place fully extended. SIR PONY BOLOGNA well placed from the start, stalked along the rail throughout, surged late vying for second place but just missed in a willing effort. GUSTO AT DAWN settled in the second flight, saved ground around the bend, bid upper stretch, leveled off needing more late. HEAVENLY EXECUTIVE tracked around the turn racing in the four path, was five wide under a drive mid stretch, improved placing but never factored. JACK VA VITE showed good early foot stalking form the three path, lacked needed rally and weakened in the drive. REBELLION DOG sent hard from the gate, cleared and angled over to the rail, headed by the winner coming to the quarter pole, had nothing left by upper stretch and gave way from mid stretch. VIVA TERRE was always outrun, offered little. CRUZINGINTHESTORM made and early retreat, no factor. KASHSURPRIZE was bumped shortly after the start, trailed throughout, never involved.
