Footnotes

SAMURAI PRINCE prompted the pace through the turn shaking clear into upper stretch, remained responsive late holding firm in the three path. ANNIKA'S LOVE hustled out pressured the pace through the turn, ceded into upper stretch holding as a clear second best at mid track. SIR HILLARY went evenly off the pace, angled toward mid track in upper stretch mustered a mild rally to best the others. PASTER'S BAD HABIT chased the pace through the turn, extending in upper stretch weakened in the four path. SUNSATIONAL slow early played no factor passing tired ones late. TALK TO DA MANAGER raced evenly off the pace lacking more. LAKE LUCERNE was never involved. SPIRIT TO RUN chased early then gave way on the turn. SURGE PROTECTOR was always outrun. PRINCEOFTHESTORMYC showed brief foot then retreated on the turn.
