Footnotes

EARLY RULER well placed, tracked to the half racing three to four wide, went up to duel outside of MARE POWER mid turn, put that rival away in upper stretch, drew off under a drive to the finish. MARE POWER hustled to the top, set a well rated pace, dueled inside of EARLY RULER from mid turn to top of the lane, proved no match but was clearly second best. ALABASTER BOX lacked speed, asked for more near the quarter pole, angled out four wide upper stretch, rallied for the show position late but was no factor. WILD DAY hustled and pressed MARE POWER in the early stages, saved ground throughout, chased from the far turn under urging, weakened top of the lane and was outfinished for the show position. CARTER'S LADY raced five wide going down the backstretch, put to a drive mid turn, did improve position but never factored. QUIET MIST raced in good stalking position, rushed along the rail to vie briefly for the lead at the half, failed to sustain bid and quickly gave way near the quarter pole. SWEETBRIAR GAL was hustled to track racing wide to the half, chased from the far turn, gave way leaving the quarter pole. MISSILE QUEEN lacked speed, dropped far behind, dull try.
