**Footnotes**

BANK OF DAD well rated early gave a prompted move on the far turn vying three deep in upper stretch gradually taking charge late. ADMIRAL'S ARCH taken back early fired out of the far turn to threaten in upper stretch, swung out four wide late came on to salvage place. BAIRDS VILLAGE moved on pace pressuring the pace through the far turn, dueling along the inside in upper stretch would cede to outside pressure. STRAIGHT COUNT sent clear set the pace under pressure from BAIRDS VILLAGE dueling on the inside to upper stretch, extended late had little left. SIR HILLARY was always outrun.
