Footnotes

DOOMER tracked evenly through the turn, angled three path top stretch, surged clear late. CONNOISSEUR pressed up on the turn, bid clear along the rail in upper stretch, was run down late. ITSAFFIRMED chased the pace four wide through the turn, extended abreast rivals upper stretch, hung late. BAND PLAYER pressed the pace through the turn, saved ground to lane, weakened there. FORMAL TESTIMONY slow early varied little through the turn, gained a bit with even action late. COPE WITH BILL off slowly angled inside to upper stretch, improved some there. FULLO SUCCESS outrun early lost ground to upper stretch, proved no factor. MOMENT SENSOR was never involved. BRAVE CHARMER labored racing wide. CHANGE PLEASE pressed early then gave way on the turn, was eased in upper stretch.
