ALIX LINDA hustled out worked to keep a short lead through the turn, digging in between horses down the stretch would find more gutting it out late. SWISS BLEND pressed and chased the pace through the turn, extended from mid track down the stretch dug deep to salvage place. DELL REEF pressed and chased the pace through the turn coming all out to upper stretch, threatening in the four path gave all to the end. LOONEY LYNDIA went evenly through the turn cutting the corner to contention in upper stretch, all out along the rail was outfinished. ROYAL TERMS slow early gave a mild move to upper stretch finishing evenly in the two path. BELLA MICHELLE a step slow through the turn raced six wide down the lane failing to menace. PASS ME A DRINK pressured the pace through the turn then wilted abruptly in upper stretch. BRIDLE BOUQUET breaking slowly would labor racing wide, was steadied the final sixteenth of a mile.
