JAY ARTHUR stalked close up through the turn, bid from mid track upper stretch, drew off driving. SHOWME ZEALOUS broke sharply, hustled a short lead through the turn to upper stretch, extending late was overpowered in the two path. ROCKY VALAY slow early saved ground to upper stretch, finished well along the inside. TOO MANY WHYZ off slowly saved ground to upper stretch, gained late near the rail. THE RAG MAN chased the pace through turn, angled six wide upper stretch, went evenly late. TRANSACTION away slowly played no factor finishing at mid track. JAKES STORM BUCK was never involved. DOUBLE DUEL went evenly through the turn then weakened in the three path upper stretch. LIVINGONAPRAYER was always outrun. IMBOOKINIT folded up on the turn, bled.
