Footnotes

HOPE DEFERED stalked close up through the turn, bid along the rail to upper stretch wresting the lead drawing out late. PLATINUM ACE away alertly worked the pace keeping a head in front through the turn, dueled to upper stretch ceding to inside pressure holding place in the two path. JUSTIFIER slow early angled five wide to upper stretch rallying late at mid track. FAST FASHION pressed the pace moving three deep through the turn, weakened in upper stretch dropping off in the four path. SIX CLICKS slow early came four wide in upper stretch finishing evenly. PETER THE GROSS pressured the pace from between horses through the turn weakening in upper stretch. UNLEADED saving ground played no factor. BLUE SOLDIER was never involved. GROWL was always outrun. CHAMP DE MARS chased early then gave way to upper stretch easing to wire.
