Footnotes

LATE DOUBLE JACK stalked the pace edging closer on the turn, drew even abreast CLEVER MISSILE in upper stretch edging clear in the three path. CLEVER MISSILE pressed the pace working a short lead through the turn, hooked on the inside in upper stretch would cede late in the two path. UPTONOW went evenly through the turn saving ground to upper stretch, angled from the two to the three path inside the eighth pole outbidding the others. WAR TALK pressured the pace through the turn then weakened in the three path upper stretch. LORDY LORDY LORDY chased early then dropped off on the turn, went evenly through the lane in the four path. FITCHVILLE a step slow through the turn played no factor. MISTER PADDY away slowly was always outrun. BORN OF FIRE pressed early then chased on the turn, gave way at the rail in upper stretch. MELLO WISHES was always outrun. GREAT RELATIONS folded up on the turn.
