PRIVATE WAGER well placed tracking a hotly contested pace going down the backside, bid five wide at the quarter pole, took slim lead mid stretch, held safe under steady encouragement to the finish. RED REEF vied early on racing between foes, had the rail dueling inside of PRIVATE WAGER from upper stretch, ceded stubbornly in deep stretch, settled for second best in a very hard effort. SYSTEMS STEVE unhurried and trailed to mid turn, came seven wide top of the stretch, closed willingly for minor award. ASMODEUS was rushed soon after the start, vied for the lead racing between rivals, battled to the quarter pole, began to tire mid stretch from earlier efforts. MY FRIEND DEKE stalked a hot pace to mid turn, bid four wide and took a slight lead near the quarter pole, failed to sustain bid and weakened mid stretch. ADVANCED SIGNS was sent hard, dueled along the rail in a four way battle, fought gamely to the quarter pole, gave way at the eighth pole, used up. SHAAMI bobbed at the break, quickly recovered, was placed behind a wall of duelers mid turn, angled under a drive entering the stretch, came up empty never menacing in the stretch. BAY BUTTON BILL was close up along the rail for the run down the backstretch, chased under urging mid turn, lacked response, faded in upper stretch.
