TRADE hustled out set the pace measuring MARCHING TUNE through the backside, drew out on the far turn widening into upper stretch winning under a drive in the two path. VALIENT TENOBOB tracked the pace through the far turn chasing TRADE into upper stretch, vying at mid track made no headway on the winner angling in late saving place. STRONG APPEAL slow early varied little through the far turn, began to respond the final eighth finishing well in the two and three path. BIG WEDNESDAY raced evenly while saving ground, roused through the far turn into upper stretch had no late surge. BREAK UP THE GAME raced second flight tiring at mid track in upper stretch. FINAL CURTAIN was never involved. MARCHING TUNE prompted the pace through the backside then gave way on the far turn.
