**Footnotes**

AIR FRAME tracked the pace racing four and five wide through the backstretch, bid to even terms three deep on the far turn, wrested the lead in upper stretch dropping to the rail taking away the path of HAPPY HIGH holding on fully extended. HAPPY HIGH stalked the pace advancing on the backside, pressed between horses on the far turn ceding a clear lead to AIR FRAME in upper stretch, was cut off by that one steadying just inside the eighth pole, angled out taking another run at the leader pressing gamely on the wire. PEGASUS HELLAS unhurried early began to respond on the far turn, angled four wide in upper stretch rallied vying boldly three deep in the final yards. CRAFTY NOBLE slow early saved ground to upper stretch mustering a mild response to improve position along the rail. IRISHWOODS slow early angled five wide to upper stretch finishing evenly at mid track. AIRLINER gave a prompted middle move threatening near the half, began to waver on the far turn giving way to upper stretch. CHUVALO sent clear set the early pace, hooked on the far turn would wilt while angling out in upper stretch. THUNDER DANCING chased the pace through the backside then folded up on the far turn. TERLINGUA'S PRINCE dropped back early. AIR FRAME WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST AND PLACED SECOND FOR INTERFERING WITH HAPPY HIGH JUST INSIDE THE EIGHTH POLE.
