PRIZE FEVER raced three wide into the first turn vying for the lead, moved clear entering the backside, set a well rated pace remained a little off the rail, threatened by THE NATIVE BLAZE at the quarter pole, repulsed that challenge and held safe late under steady pressure. SARAROYAL settled in the second flight, launched rally coming three wide at the quarter pole, was slowly closing in on the wire in deep stretch but settled for second best in a good effort. ITSALLABOUTMENOW unhurried from the gate traveling towards the rear, gained momentum leaving the quarter pole, angled four wide upper stretch, closed willingly in deep stretch picking up the show position. THE NATIVE BLAZE stalked the winner from the start, bid three wide to loom at the quarter pole, failed to sustain move and flattened out mid stretch. MIDNIGHT ABBEY pressed the winner to the half racing along the rail, began to drop off at the quarter pole, angled out giving chase in upper stretch, weakened in the drive. DEVOUCOUX lagged far off the early pace, mildly bid in the lane improving position but failed to factor. DECEMBER DIVA settled in the second flight, lacked needed response when roused, never menaced. NAE PROBLEM raced five wide into the first turn, traveled wide down the backside in mid pack, faded mid turn. DANCING TIGER tracked the pace running in the four path, gave way on the turn, never threatening.
