Footnotes

SAINTLY TALE well placed tracking the pace running along the inside to the far turn, angled mid turn, bid near the quarter pole, inherited the lead when SHARP PICK bore out entering the stretch, vied in a three way battle in upper stretch, edged away late under strong handling. CALLIDE VALLEY settled towards the rear saving ground, rallied along the rail from mid turn, cut the corner top of the lane, vied inside the winner in upper stretch, was turned away proving a willing second best. SHARP PICK hustled into the first turn racing four wide taking the lead, remained off the rail setting the pace down the backside, bore out entering the stretch proving very costly, came again from mid stretch getting up for third place in a good effort. BATTLE MOUNTAIN raced in good tracking position traveling in the four path, gave chase under a stiff drive top of the lane, lacked needed punch never menacing. FAST PROMISES stalked down the backside running three wide, almost drew even in a three way battle in upper stretch, failed to sustain move and weakened inside the eighth pole. BOOYA SKEE DADDY raced in the second flight throughout, failed to respond when roused, never threatened. PLAN AHEAD showed good early speed dueling for the lead to the half, was all done leaving the quarter pole. SPIRIT OF WISDOM was outrun offering little. SICOMORO struggled in the opening strides, was pulled up entering the backstretch, rider dismounted and was vanned off.
