HIGH HERITAGE stalked RAIN SONG from the start racing mid track, asked leaving the quarter pole, quickly moved on the leader to match strides entering the stretch, went clear and widened easily being ridden out. JUST MICHEL lacked speed, raced wide early, angled to the rail on the bend, rallied into the lane, angled out near the sixteenth pole, surged late to gain the place position in a willing manner. RAIN SONG showed high speed, raced with a clear lead mid turn, was headed by HIGH HERITAGE turning for home, proved no match and was out finished late, settled for the show position. SHE'S THAT CAT raced evenly and angled to the rail shortly after the start, chased from the quarter pole, was aggressively ridden in the drive, had no response. PATRICIA'S SECRET tracked racing four wide, roused mid turn, swung six wide into the stretch, failed to rally. ELECTRICAL CARLITA hustled to stalk briefly, put to a drive mid turn, lacked rally, was five wide top of the lane, tired at the eighth pole. CHAREDI'S PEAK lacked speed, weakened at the quarter pole, no factor. THE GREAT TYLER showed brief foot, chased to mid turn, gave way at the quarter pole, stopped mid stretch.
