QUEEN GRACIE was patiently ridden leaving the gate, angled to mid turn leaving the far turn, advanced at the quarter pole almost drawing even in a three way duel, finally edged away from a stubborn SHARP N FLASHY in deep stretch, won going away being ridden out. SHARP N FLASHY broke alert and dueled for command soon after the start, raced towards the inside around the bend in a three way battle, held slim lead mid stretch matching strides with the winner, ceded grudgingly coming to the wire missing in a very game effort. MERGE hustled from the gate, vied for the lead down the backside, dueled between foes at the quarter pole, fought hard to mid stretch, came up short late to settle for third place in a hard try. TORINADO tracked a contested pace running four to five wide throughout, failed to kick in when asked, finished evenly. PORT OF GOLD trailed soon after the start, angled four wide under a drive in upper stretch, mildly responded improving placing but never threatened. AN ICEY AFFAIR showed good early speed tracking a contested pace, began to chase under urging mid turn, weakened in the drive. WEZAR lacked speed racing mid track, swung six wide into the lane, failed to menace. SATIN ROSE made an early fade dropping off to trail midway on the turn, showed little.
