POSH LADY pressured early wresting a clear lead on the turn, widened under a stiff drive along the inside in upper stretch holding firm from the eighth pole. BRAND J C saved ground while tracking the pace through the turn, angled out five wide in upper stretch rallying from mid track for place. LADY SAXONY stalked the pace through the turn extending from the three path upper stretch, making no headway on the winner would hang late. CUP'N SPOON bumped with NEW MEXICO SAND at the break, tracked evenly through the turn coming four wide upper stretch, lacked surge holding position late. L. A. EXPRESS chased the pace staying close through the turn, wavered in upper stretch dropping off along the rail. MISS DEVIL HER DUE pressed early then ceded on the turn giving way to upper stretch. LEXITUDE a step slow early played no factor. OFFLEE SWEET was always outrun. NEW MEXICO SAND bumped with CUP'N SPOON at the break laboring after.
