EMILY SUN SHINE stalked the pace pressing up three deep on the turn, shook clear in the four path upper stretch holding firm the final eighth. ELIZABETH'S DREAM slow early moved up on the turn, angled six wide in upper stretch vied willingly late. WALTZING TIME hustled out chased early then pressed up to challenge on the turn, ceding to EMILY SUN SHINE in upper stretch angled from the three to the five path while weakening late. THIS CATS ON FIRE chased the pace drawing closer on the turn, came five wide in upper stretch drifting inside while fading late. HONOUR FIRST broke alertly setting the early pace, hooked on the turn would wilt along the inside in upper stretch. BEA'S HARD SIX a step slow early was hustled through the turn, had little left in upper stretch. EMPRESS BAY slow early was always outrun being taken seven wide in upper stretch. IMA GIVEN hustled along in mid pack would fold in upper stretch.
