Footnotes

FIRST IN well placed saving ground around the bend, launched rally coming three to four wide top of the lane, drove by a game THIS IS ELIZA a sixteenth out to win going away. THIS IS ELIZA sent early, dueled around the turn racing between foes while off the rail, edged clear mid stretch, was overpowered by FIRST IN near the sixteenth pole to settle for a game second best. STREET MATE rushed hard into the far turn, traveled towards the inside when THIS IS ELIZA remained mid track, battled hard to mid stretch the yielded to best rest. MISS HORSE DOCTOR lunged as the gate opened and trailed soon after, made a steady advance from the quarter pole, raced five to six wide from upper stretch showing late interest improving placing. MORE SWEET SECRETS showed good early speed pressing for the lead, could not keep pace turning for home, weakened in the lane. TEXAS FLEETING well placed tracking duelers around the turn running four wide, failed to respond when roused tiring in the lane. CHAPELLA lacked speed running towards the rear throughout, offered little. MISS HUME TOWNSHIP quickly faded from mid turn finishing well beaten. FIRST IN WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST TO UNPLACED FOR A MEDICATION VIOLATION.
