AIRBORNE ANGEL well placed, tracked patiently through the backstretch, roused for bid on turn, fired top lane, surged in steady fashion from the 1/8 pole, went clear. UNREAL CAT rushed to top, hustled off to big lead, leg weary late, run down. AS GREAT AS SHE IS settled early, advanced inside, swung 5 wide to lane, leveled off late. SIR'S AFFAIR slow early, saved ground, minor gain turn, angled wide, no menace. CADA outrun early, little change to 1/2, mild move turn, no menace. STIR N THINGS UP dropped well back, labored to 1/2, fanned wide, no factor. I'M GONNA SHINE pushed along 4 wide, flattened out. BELLE DAMSEL sent hard to front, chased loose leader, empty on turn. RED GINNY slow early, pulled up near the 3/8 pole.
