WHISPER AND RUN away alertly, stalked early, pressed to lead, widened, held urged. SEA DAISY unhurried, evenly backside, angled to mid track, surged. SILVER INVITATION dropped well back, sluggish to lane, found belated stride. COME FLY WITH ME well placed, tracked pace, swung out lane, closed to wire. VISALIA DUST laid close up, roused to bid second turn, leveled off lane. MINT SWIRL slow early, never fired. ANSWER DANCER lost ground, flattened out. TYPICAL BRAGG sent to top, collared backside, wilted.
