THE GREAT TYLER hustled from the gate, dueled inside of STORMIN JANETROSE to near the 1/4 pole, edged away from that rival and came three wide entering the stretch, was under a stiff drive and held safe to the wire in a very game effort. KING'S THRILL was unhurried from the start, asked mid turn, swung 5 wide top of the lane, was under left handed pressure in the lane, closed gap in willing performance. DAVID'S DILEMMA raced evenly early, roused at the 3/8 pole, bid along the rail in upper stretch, loomed at the 1/16 pole, was outfinished late in a hard try. QUEENOFMOUNTAIN trailed early, roused in upper stretch, split foes at the 1/16 pole, made a fast finish approaching the wire. FINANCIAL RISK was off just a step slow, rushed from there, tracked pace on the turn, angled out upper stretch,was hard ridden but weakened at the 1/8 pole. MISS BONN BONN showed good early speed, stalked while 3-4 wide on the turn, was hard ridden entering the stretch but lacked rally. STORMIN JANETROSE sent hard, dueled outside of THE GREAT TYLER to near the 1/4 pole, tired in upper stretch and gave way at the 1/8 pole. MINEY'S AWESOME raced evenly early, faded on the turn, lost ground into the stretch, no factor.
