MIGRANT showed good speed leaving the gate, vied for the lead racing between foes around the bend, asked for more top of the lane, responded to draw off from the eighth pole, won comfortably being ridden out. SEATTLE EXPRESSO raced up close from the start, loomed off the winner at the quarter pole traveling four wide, proved no match leaving the furlong marker but was a game second best. GEODI'S GOLD hustled from the gate, battled along the rail early on, began to tire in deep stretch, besting rest in a hard effort. WHODATE PYRITE was forwardly placed throughout, lost a bit of ground running five wide mid turn, came four wide into the stretch under a stiff drive, lacked closing punch. MUY MACHO was hustled early, raced up close and was in tight mid turn, angled out top of the lane, failed to menace despite being hard ridden. RUMMY'S COMMAND was off a step slow and trailed to the quarter pole, swung seven wide entering the stretch, mildly improved but never threatened. BARE ADVANTAGE lacked speed racing towards the rear, swung six wide top of the lane, failed to factor. AZSTOR was hustled leaving the gate, raced mid track around the bend, failed to menace. MATHUGHS JOURNEY raced in good tracking position running between foes mid turn, chased under a drive entering the stretch, lacked response and gave way in the drive.
