HARPERS LAND tracked evenly through the far turn, rallied inside upper stretch splitting horses in the two path drawing clear. KOKOMO GYPSY laid close up looming a threat through the far turn, bid gamely between horses in the four path down the stretch. ETHICS REFORM stalked close up pressing hard on the far turn, extending abreast rivals from mid track down the stretch was outfinished. PIPER'S FRIEND set the pace on a short lead through the backside, hooked along the inside on the far turn would duel to upper stretch weakening while in close quarters late. CLASSY SCAMP prompted the pace pressing and dueling through the far turn, wavered in the three path upper stretch. BENJAMIN E. saved ground cutting the corner to upper stretch, bidding along the rail would level off. BOOYA SKEE DADDY was always outrun. KENNY THE SALESMAN failed to respond finishing at mid track.
