**Footnotes**

GONE GRAND rushed soon after the start, dueled briefly with FLIP FLOP, cleared and angled to the rail at the quarter pole, opened up top of the lane, was kept to task late winning comfortably. JUDGE FUDGE rated early racing in the second flight, rallied seven wide entering the stretch, finished strongly gaining the place position. JET FLAG settled in the second flight, angled six wide into the lane, bid mid stretch, was outfinished nearing the wire vying for second place. SAUCY'S IMAGE tracked racing towards the inside around the turn, bid two wide while between foes top of the lane, tired late missing a minor award. NEVEREVERYIELD off slowly, trailed to the quarter pole, was angled out six wide mid stretch, put to aggressive handling and surged belatedly. AWESOME AFFAIR flashed speed, dropped off mid turn, came again racing six wide upper stretch, improved placing but never menaced. LADY BOBCAT CHAMPS was forwardly placed from the start, gave chase from the quarter pole, lacked rally and weakened in the drive. FLIP FLOP pressed the winner for the early lead, moved off the rail around the turn giving chase, was all done mid stretch and faded running between foes. ASISA'S ASSAULT tracked early, rushed a four wide move at the quarter pole, loomed briefly, soon gave way upper stretch. GIFTS FOR A KING struggled shortly after the start, was pulled up mid turn, vanned off.
