Footnotes

A. P. SIERRA raced evenly through the turn rallying to put a head in front upper stretch, dug in to outside pressure from HEAVENLY EXECUTIVE holding on gamely at mid track. HEAVENLY EXECUTIVE slow early circled out into upper stretch, bid boldly six wide pressing the winner to the wire. GET THERE stalked evenly through the turn, bid from the three path upper stretch weakening late under outside pressure. PALACE CAUSEWAY pressed and chased on the inside through the turn, extending from the rail upper stretch would come up short. NO ROOM raced evenly throughout lacking a late response in the four path. UNIVERSALIS chased the pace through the turn, angled seven wide in upper stretch would wear out. KISS THAT TIGER broke alertly wresting the lead working to clear on the turn, hooked in the two path upper stretch would wilt. IANS POSH struggled far back.
