BEPPONE broke in to brush POLAR ECLIPSE at the start, rushed up taking a short lead, dueled with HONORABLEGENTLEMEN to the quarter pole, left the field behind from upper stretch, won as much the best being ridden out. CARTER'S PRIDE raced up close down the backstretch, gave chase from mid turn running between rivals, was under a drive to get up late for second place but never threatened the winner. HONORABLEGENTLEMEN broke out but was quickly rushed up to vie for the lead, battled to the quarter pole, faltered near the sixteenth pole losing second place in last jumps. SENSATIONAL JACOB tracked down the backside running in the four path, raced abreast foes vying for a minor award top of the lane, lacked needed surge besting rest. WAMBRI raced evenly in the second flight at mid track, never factored. SHININGINTHEWORLD was urged leaving the gate, failed to respond, offered little throughout. DINAKA was quickly outrun running far behind, never involved. POLAR ECLIPSE raced up close along the rail to mid turn, stopped entering the stretch and finished being eased across the finish line.
