Footnotes

READY FOR DUTY vied for the lead, moved clear at the quarter pole, led entering the stretch running in the three path, dug in late under strong handling to prevail being fully extended. BACK TO GOLD rated early traveling in the second flight, split foes at the quarter pole, angled towards the inside mid stretch, surged on the winner nearing the wire just missing in a hard try. BLITZ ECLIPSE raced evenly along the rail trailing early, swung out seven wide losing ground entering the stretch, finished fastest of all in the final furlong securing the show position. CANDY HEART raced up close early on, bid three wide to loom off the leader at the quarter pole, needed more late being outfinished for a minor award. SUGAR STORM tracked around the turn, bid four wide at the quarter pole, failed to sustain move flattening out mid stretch. SENOR SMILEY flashed brief foot racing up close to mid turn, angled out four to five wide under a drive top of the lane, failed to rally. AUDITORIUM lacked speed and trailed on the turn, never menaced. CIHANGIR (IRE) was hard used leaving the gate, dueled running along the rail to the quarter pole, gave way upper stretch finishing spent.
