EMMA'S HOLY BEE broke alertly setting the pace hustling clear on the turn, widened the margin in upper stretch then drifted out when tiring late holding up in the end. RED HEN WALKING went evenly through the turn, emerged off a loose EMMA'S HOLY BEE in upper stretch, angled from the four to six path as the leader drifted late gaining with every stride. BOSSY GIRL sent hard chased the pace through the turn saving ground to upper stretch, extending in the two path late would weaken. COLARFUL SONG raced evenly off the pace coming three wide to upper stretch proving no menace while holding position. BROOK'S SECRET was always a step slow. ONE EYED SHOOK away slowly dropped well back early as no factor. BURNT COFFEE veering in at the break was always outrun.
