BLACK FEATHER rushed shortly after the start, pressed then vied for command racing four wide and between foes throughout, gained a slight edge in upper stretch, held firm under strong handling to the finish. CARDIOLOGIST sent hard from the gate, dueled throughout racing along the rail, battled every step to the wire with the winner, yielded grudgingly in a very determined effort. SURGE PROTECTOR tracked a hotly contested pace going down the backside, bid five wide coming to the quarter pole, vied abreast foes top of the lane, was outfinished from the eighth pole, just lasted for third place. OH EMM GEE raced greenly in the early going and lagged to mid turn, swung seven wide entering the stretch receiving strong left handed stick found stride and closed in fast nearing the finish line. ALY RAJA settled in the second flight, bid six wide into the lane, loomed holding a menacing position from the eighth pole, hung in deep stretch. CORUSCATION sent hard, vied early on racing three wide and between foes around the bend, put a head in front at the quarter pole, faded inside the furlong marker from earlier efforts. INDIO MULA showed good speed, pressed the runner up to the far turn racing along the rail, could not keep pace past the three eighths, faded in the lane. SUSAN'S WONDERBOY lacked speed and dropped far off the pace midway on the turn finishing well beaten.
