CINDER CONE moved off the rail entering the backstretch to stalk SMARTTHINK'TONY to the half, drew even on the far turn, inched clear at the quarter pole, increased margin under a drive top of the lane, held firm late receiving steady pressure. PARTY LANG rated in the early going, rallied five wide leaving the quarter pole, battled for the place position from mid stretch, got the nod in last jump, game effort. HURLEY'S WAY unhurried and trailed early, quickly gained from mid turn, dueled from upper stretch for a minor award, was edged out in last stride, settled for the show position in willing effort. I'M WAITING FOR U tracked to the half, mildly bid on the turn, lacked needed kick. SMARTTHINKIN'TONY quickly showed in front, moved off the rail going into the first turn, headed by the winner on the far turn, battled to the quarter pole, angled four wide upper stretch giving chase, faded mid stretch, used up. EL WINDO showed brief foot, chased to the far turn, angled inside at the quarter pole, no factor in the drive. RED SANDY tracked under a rating to the half, set down on the bend, failed to quicken, drifted six wide while weakening in upper stretch. EPPING lagged far behind, never involved.
