FIRE ROAD rushed hard into the far turn, moved clear mid turn, held safe to the finish under strong encouragement. BARBARA'S CHOICE settled in good tracking position, bid four wide at the quarter pole, dug in late saving second place under a stiff drive. ROCKET RICHIE raced up close along the inside soon after the start, lacked needed surge despite being hard ridden, needed more late. BLUEGRASS DREAMER settled in the second flight, swung out five wide under a drive upper stretch, lacked needed punch. SEASIDE NATIVE was sent hard and battled for the early lead, began to weaken mid stretch, no late factor. ROLLIN CATAMINE was outrun to the quarter pole, angled six wide upper stretch, found belated stride finishing with interest but never menaced. NEWYORKJOE lacked speed traveling in the second flight and off the rail, roused into the lane, angled inside mid stretch, failed to respond, no threat. CHANGE YOUR BET angled to the rail shortly after the start, tracked to the quarter pole, failed to respond when asked for more and faded in the drive. POLISH SAUSAGE was always outrun, gave way past the quarter pole, dull effort.
