COACH SHAW unhurried and trailed down the backside, raced towards the inside around the bend, angled out five wide top of the lane, hit stride and made a powerful finish to win going away. MAGESTIC HEART was hard used early, set a pressured pace throughout traveling in the two path, was overpowered a sixteenth out proving a game second best. JUSTIFIER stumbled and took up briefly at the break and was then bumped by BOBS TIEBREAKER, moved to the rail shortly after, gained to a menacing position entering the stretch, leveled off mid stretch while saving third place late in a hard effort. GULLY HILL ROAD pressed for the lead from the start, vied entering the stretch racing between foes, tired inside the eighth pole just being edged out of third place. SHIVE'S SUCCESS trailed mid turn, responded from upper stretch traveling along the rail, showed action after the fact. AURORA'S SECRET raced evenly at mid track, swung seven wide upper stretch, failed to menace and was vanned off after the race. UMBANI well placed from the start, raced up close running three wide at the quarter pole, gave way mid stretch. BOBS TIEBREAKER broke in bumping JUSTIFIER shortly after the start, hustled down the backside, raced five wide chasing entering the stretch, gave way mid stretch.
