Footnotes

EASTERMAN was patiently ridden down the backside, sat off duelers to the far turn, bid between foes mid turn, angled to the rail at the quarter pole, battled in three way duel entering the stretch, dug in running along the rail from the three sixteenths, finally inched clear in last jumps gaining a hard earned victory being fully extended. MEISTERWERK stalked soon after the start racing two wide, alternated foe the lead from the far turn, matched strides with the winner to deep stretch, ceded grudgingly coming to the wire missing in a very game try. GAME APPEAL rated early, angled off the rail at the half, rallied four wide leaving the quarter pole, loomed off of top pair in upper stretch, was turned away needing more late. HONOR EVENING rated early, set down mid turn, bid entering the stretch holding a menacing position, failed to sustain move and flattened out mid stretch. VOW TO FLY raced up close to the half, chased under urging mid turn, came up empty giving way in upper stretch. WEEKEND AT ROMERO vied for the lead running along the rail for the opening half mile, had enough and gave way leaving the quarter pole, finished spent.
