BROTHER KEITH tracked around the bend, came five wide top of the lane, closed in nearing the wire, was outfinished late vying for second place. SNUCK IN THE DANCE pressed to the quarter pole racing three wide, could not keep pace from mid stretch, bested rest. SILVER SPIKE vied for the early lead, raced up close to the quarter pole, began to fade upper stretch, used up. JULIAN LOVE lacked speed racing wide around the turn, failed to menace. ONE FINE ENDEAVOUR was quickly outrun, never involved, dull try.
