Footnotes

ROSES FROM DORA broke alert rushing on the turn to grab a short lead, dug in from the four path responding to left handed urging to hold firm down the stretch. CASE SAID broke well following ROSES FROM DORA close up through the turn, loomed abreast rival under a stiff drive would be turned back while saving place. OUR LILLY bumped by MACKINAW ISLAND leaving the gate was hustled to go close up pursuing on the inside of rivals to upper stretch, extended in drive hung the final sixteenth. QUIZ THE MAID ducked out leaving the starting gate, dropping to last on the turn was circled out five wide in upper stretch, threatening at mid track late would lack needed punch. METALLIC MISS hustled in early pursuit dropped back into the turn with no recovery. DESERT STAR weakened on the turn. HONOR THY SPIRIT broke sharply to a brief lead then gave way on the turn. BURNT BUSH showed little. MACKINAW ISLAND veered out bumping OUR LILLY bobbling after the break, ducked to the rail wilting on the turn.
