REDSTONE ARSENAL sent hard pressed to a short lead on the turn, hooked in upper stretch was headed then battled back gamely to prevail. KYLE'S TREASURY went evenly, was rushed up on the turn, came five wide dueling in upper stretch, led late then was out gamed in the closing yards. GENERAL DEPUTY hustled in pursuit pressed on the turn then weakened in drive. RIGHT NICE raced at mid pack, came hard roused to lane, lacked a late surge. WEST TO DURANGO stumbled at the break, was rushed to contention racing wide on the turn, losing ground to upper stretch would weaken the final eighth. CELTIC FIRE was always outrun. GLORIED showed little. CAYENNE GREY struggled throughout. GOIN ON A HUNCH rushed up pressuring the pace, dueled on the turn then wilted to upper stretch. GLITTERESSENCE refused to break.
