FATHER'S MIG quickly showed in front, set all the pace racing in hand from the three path, threatened by LAMUIM entering the stretch, floated that rival out a bit in upper stretch, responded to encouragement and widened late winning convincingly. LAMUIM stalked the winner down the backside, bid four wide entering the stretch, almost drew even top of the lane, was turned away and settled for second place in a willing manner. BIOGIO'S LEGEND unhurried early racing in the second flight, roused mid turn, came five wide mounting rally upper stretch, closed willingly picking up the show position. J'S REDBUD SPIRIT lacked speed running towards the rear, moved to mid track on the bend, lost ground angling out eight wide upper stretch, surged belatedly improving placing but never menaced. HENRY'S TIME was moved off the rail shortly after the start, swung out seven wide upper stretch, rallied belatedly but never threatened. PETER THE GROSS stalked down the backside, raced between foes mid turn, lost position into the lane, was outfinished late fighting for a minor award. MATTY'S ENFORCER raced along the rail in mid pack, failed to respond when roused, weakened in the drive. OMEGA ME AMIGO was slow into stride, trailed soon after, raced wide throughout, never factored. GIN KINGS flashed brief foot, gave way near the quarter pole finishing well beaten.
