HONEST EXPECTATION stalked early edging closer on the turn, moved past I'D MARRY ME to take charge in upper stretch drawing out under urging at mid track. I'D MARRY ME broke sharply hustling the pace through the turn, overpowered in upper stretch would stay on in the three path salvaging place. IM GOOD AT THAT tracked the pace through the turn, traveling evenly in the six path down the stretch lacked surge holding position. JULES CAESAR chased early then dropped off on the turn, angled to the three path in upper stretch finishing evenly. TOUGH TURKEY raced mid pack early dropping back on the turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch posed no menace. CAPTAIN BOB JO JR. away slowly came eight wide in upper stretch giving a mild late response. SON OF SABATO was bumped and crowded at the break, swung out seven wide in upper stretch. SPIRIT TO RUN folded up on the turn. SIRR PURR was always outrun before tiring.
