CHA CHA FOR NOW slow early rallied out of the turn looming abreast rivals at mid track in upper stretch, angled inside dueling late edging up under extension. SPIN THE WHEEL pressured the pace through the turn, dueled between horses down the stretch being carried inside ceding grudgingly late in the two path. MAMA DUKES hustled out set a pressured pace through the turn, dueling inside of rivals down the stretch was carried to the rail coming up a bit short. MAGNIFICENT MILE went evenly in mid pack through the turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch loomed lacking a final surge. MARIA'S MOON moved evenly throughout playing no factor. SEA WHY was always a step slow. CART MARTIAL was always outrun. TOORALLOORACOLLORA had brief speed then retreated on the turn.
