Footnotes

KUTLOOSE broke out tightening up MY VIOLIN leaving the gate, rushed up to take control, set the pace running in the three path, held a clear advantage entering the stretch, began to tire in deep stretch and was put to a drive holding safe late. ZARCH hustled into the far turn, stalked the winner from mid turn, swung out four wide top of the stretch, did narrow the gap nearing the wire under strong handling finishing a game second best. E. T. ANGEL tracked around the turn racing four to five wide, failed to respond when roused, bested rest. DANCE N FIT broke a bit awkwardly, raced towards the rear along the rail, mildly bid from upper stretch but never menaced. CADENCE'S ACCOLADE varied little traveling in the second flight, never factored. CONSOLVER rushed from the gate pressing the winner briefly, began to weaken in upper stretch, no threat. MY VIOLIN was in tight at the break when KUTLOOSE broke outward, trailed thereafter offering little.
