Footnotes

PERFECTLY PLAYED away slowly stayed back through the turn, circled out while advancing coming eight wide in upper stretch surging the final sixteenth sweeping up in the six path at the wire. DOWN THE ROAD slow early was outrun through the turn, fired in the three path in upper stretch leading late only to be grabbed from the outside at the wire. TUFFY COTTRELL broke alertly pressuring the pace through the turn, working to a short lead in upper stretch would cede late between horses. BROTHER KEITH chased the pace edging closer on the turn, dueled from mid track in upper stretch extending late coming up short. PURE RUSH bobbled leaving the gate, was rushed along through the turn drifting out to the seven path in upper stretch weakening there. HOPEFUL BANDIT trailing through the turn was taken out seven wide in upper stretch. ON TOUR chased the pace through the turn then wilted in upper stretch. AVOID pressured the pace wresting the lead on the turn, wilted to pressure in upper stretch. GO YANKEES dropped back on the turn.
