EXULTANT dueled with MY HOT CHILI to the half setting rapid fractions, put that rival away midway on the final turn, drew off top of the stretch, won comfortable being ridden out. VENTURE EXCHANGE settled in the second flight, advanced mid turn splitting rivals, rallied from upper stretch traveling two to three wide, narrowed the gap on the winner finishing in a willing manner. D'WOP D'WOP angled to the rail shortly after the start, stalked the winner throughout, failed to respond when roused top of the stretch, held third place needing more late. DOLCE LUSSO unhurried and trailed in the early going, gained momentum near the quarter pole, swung out five wide upper stretch, showed belated action improving placing. BREWZER tracked throughout, set down racing four wide and between rivals upper stretch, failed to menace finishing evenly. SPURIOUS rated and raced towards the rear, angled four to five wide upper stretch, mildly bid then leveled off late. MY HOT CHILI was hard used dueling with the winner to the half, dropped off turning for home finishing spent. NATIVE SOLEIL raced evenly in the second flight and a little off the rail, lacked rally never factoring. DOUBLE RING made a steady fade from the half, no factor. SHE'S LYING AGAIN hustled into the first turn, chased briefly, gave way mid turn finishing weary.
