WHY IZZY WHY slow early advanced out of the turn, took aim in the three path being roused clear late. STRIPE E broke alertly pressing the pace on a short lead through the turn, widened in the two path upper stretch digging in late to no avail. GLOW GIRL GO went evenly saving ground to upper stretch, bid all out along the rail the final eighth. FLOWER GIRL a step slow through the turn came five wide in upper stretch responding with a late surge. START STREET gave hard pursuit through the turn then weakened in the four path upper stretch. STRIPED LADY slow early played no factor. LEATHER LACES had brief position before giving way on the turn. VALARI raced evenly in mid pack through the turn tiring in upper stretch. DID YOU KNOW pressed early then gave way on the turn.
