PASSION RULES stalked the pace following STARK RAVIN MAD through the turn into upper stretch, gave steady surge from the eighth pole edging past the tiring leader to win clear. STARK RAVIN MAD rushed clear early hustled the lead through the turn into upper stretch, digging in along the rail shortened stride inside the sixteenth pole ceding to PASSION RULES while barely hanging on for place. KING THOU ART fractious in the gate pre start was settled off the pace, saved ground to upper stretch firing in the two path bidding gamely late. MOB BOSS slow early angled four wide to upper stretch, moved out toward mid track responded with late surge. SOLD MY SOUL slow early varied little through the turn, racing four path down the lane proved no menace. SIX MILLER'S played no factor. CALL MY JOB away slowly would struggle throughout. GAME CHANGER chased early then wavered on the turn giving way while in close at the head of the stretch.
