Footnotes

FORMAL GULCH dueled racing three wide down the backstretch, moved clear leaving the far turn and angled to the rail, opened up at the quarter pole, was under left handed stick in the final furlong as the lead was diminishing, just lasted being fully extended. FINISHING TOUCH unhurried leaving the gate, trailed to the half, made a quick four wide move bid mid turn, closed in on the winner nearing the finish line, just missed proving second best. DIA XENIA dueled into the first turn racing between foes, took back entering the backside to stalk, asked coming again top of the lane, edged up late securing third place in a hard try. DON'T SURPRISE ME settled in the second flight, traveled three wide on the turn, angled out five wide mid stretch, bid belatedly missing third place. HONG KONG LAKE stalled to the half running three to four wide, began to tire turning for home, no late threat. BIG DEBBIE tracked the pace racing in the four path to the half, lacked response when roused, tired upper stretch. CHOKOLOOSKEE raced briefly in the second flight, made an early fade, showed little. SLIGO BREEZE pressed the winner to the half, was all done giving way midway on the second turn finishing spent.
