Footnotes

VALIENT TENOBBOB slow early saved ground cutting the corner to hook RED HOT HUMOR in upper stretch, dug in along the rail edging clear gamely. RED HOT HUMOR sent clear set the pace coming under pressure on the turn, challenged from the inside by VALIENT TENOBBOB in upper stretch would prove no match holding well to secure pace in the two path. BELIEVE DAT stalked then pressured the pace through the turn, dropped off the front end in upper stretch giving even response near mid track to hold the others safe. NIMBLE TIGER raced evenly angling out near the quarter pole, came six wide in upper stretch failing to menace. CALL THE GUY always a step behind was swung six wide in upper stretch. GOOD TO SEE YOU bumped at the break was rushed up on the turn threatening four wide, lost momentum in upper stretch fading at mid track. GALLOWAY PAIGE offered little finishing up inside.
