MIRACLE IN MAY well rated fired on the far turn bidding clear in the three path upper stretch, held well the final eighth under right hand urging. URA WILD WON unhurried early advanced to contention out of the far turn vying in the three path getting up late for place. ASHBY LAND taken back early was roused to action on the far turn, angled four wide in upper stretch vied willingly late. EMILY SUN SHINE stalked the pace through the far turn saving ground into upper stretch, wore down there along the rail. SHELIA slow early was never involved racing seven wide through the stretch. HOLD ME MOLLY stalked the pace for half a mile then weakened on the far turn giving way to upper stretch. JULESNOMENCLATOR sent clear set the pace through the far turn then folded abruptly when engaged in upper stretch. DEL BONITA was always outrun.
