Footnotes

CLASS AX rushed to the front, opened up leaving the quarter pole, raced a little off the rail entering the stretch, was kept busy winning well clear at the finish. OCHO CABALLOS stalked the winner from the start, raced three wide giving chase around the turn, failed to menace in the lane digging in late saving second place. DUTY ROSTER unhurried early racing towards the rear, split foes turning for home, angled out five wide mid stretch, closed willingly picking up the show position. SIRR PURR was outrun to the quarter pole, angled top of the lane, hit stride finishing strongly in deep stretch. PULASKI COUNTY stalked down the backstretch, put to a drive mid turn, lacked response and tired inside the eighth pole. TEXAS HOLLADAY raced evenly at mid track, failed to respond when roused, no threat. WILD INQUIRY settled in mid pack, mounted a mild bid top of the lane traveling towards the inside, soon flattened out mid stretch. BOOGIEMANBALL lacked speed racing wide down the backside, offered little. TAKE AIM well placed down the backside racing along the rail, could not keep pace leaving the quarter pole, gave way in the drive. THE ONE TO CHASE settled in the second flight, gave way top of the stretch.
